Deploying a Surface Marker Buoy

ON BOAT DIVES, YOU ARE REQUIRED TO CARRY AN SMB, SO YOU MIGHT AS WELL LEARN TO USE IT.

IT AIN'T ROCKET SURGERY, BUT IT MAY TAKE SOME PRACTICE.

Why deploy an SMB?

You deploy the SMB so the boat you are diving off of can find you when you surface

So other boat traffic knows you are in the water and avoid you

When to deploy the SMB:

On the surface – it is acceptable, especially when you first start using an SMB

At your Safety Stop – for safety reasons, it is preferable to surface deployment; boat traffic knows where you are before you try to surface.

Before you reach your Safety Stop - better still, so you don't overshoot your safety stop with a run-away SMB.

Ways to inflate your SMB:



With you Low Pressure Inflator hose

► With your Octo line

Tip 1:

I. Using a double-ended spring-loaded bolt snap with your reel



Tip 2:

Disconnect bolt-snap from reel BEFORE inflating SMB, or say good-bye to your SMB and reel.
