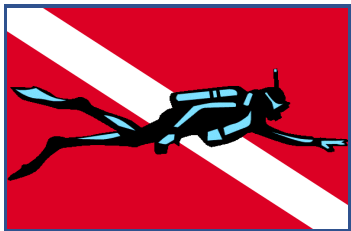

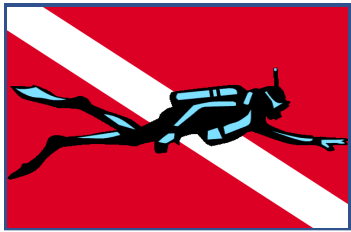


Pre-Dive Planning

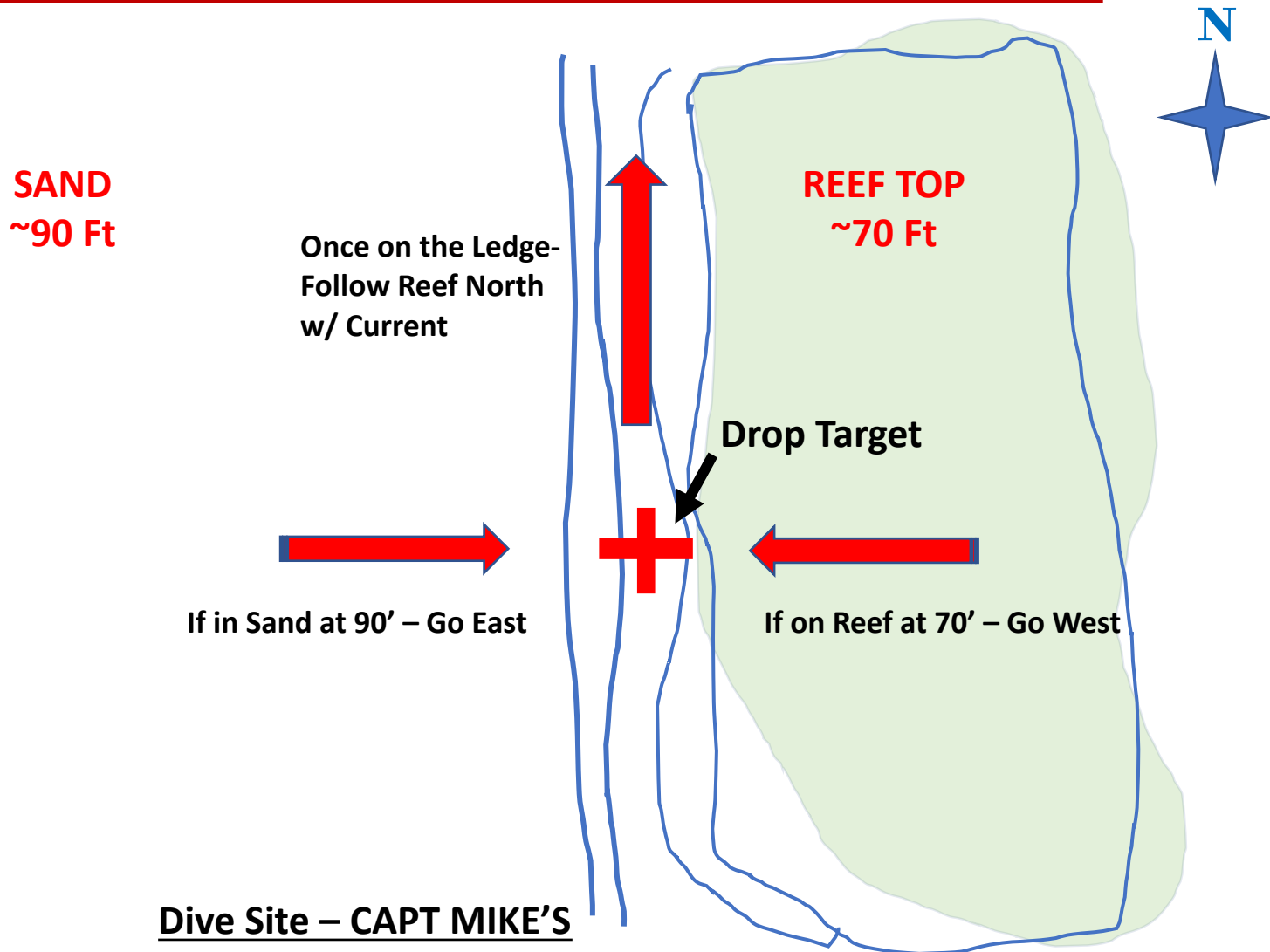


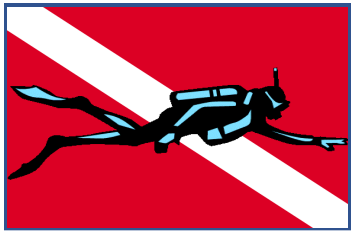
Planning Your Dive is Critical to a Successful Dive:

- Always important to listen to the Dive Briefing to know the Plan for Executing the Dive.
- Plan your Dive with your Buddy(ies) within the overall Dive Brief.
- Should also discuss contingencies in case the Dive does NOT go as planned.
 - Separation Procedures – Planned Actions.
 - Actions if Subgoals of Dive don't materialize.
 - When and How to "Pull the Plug".
 - Etc.
- Then, Execute Your Plan.

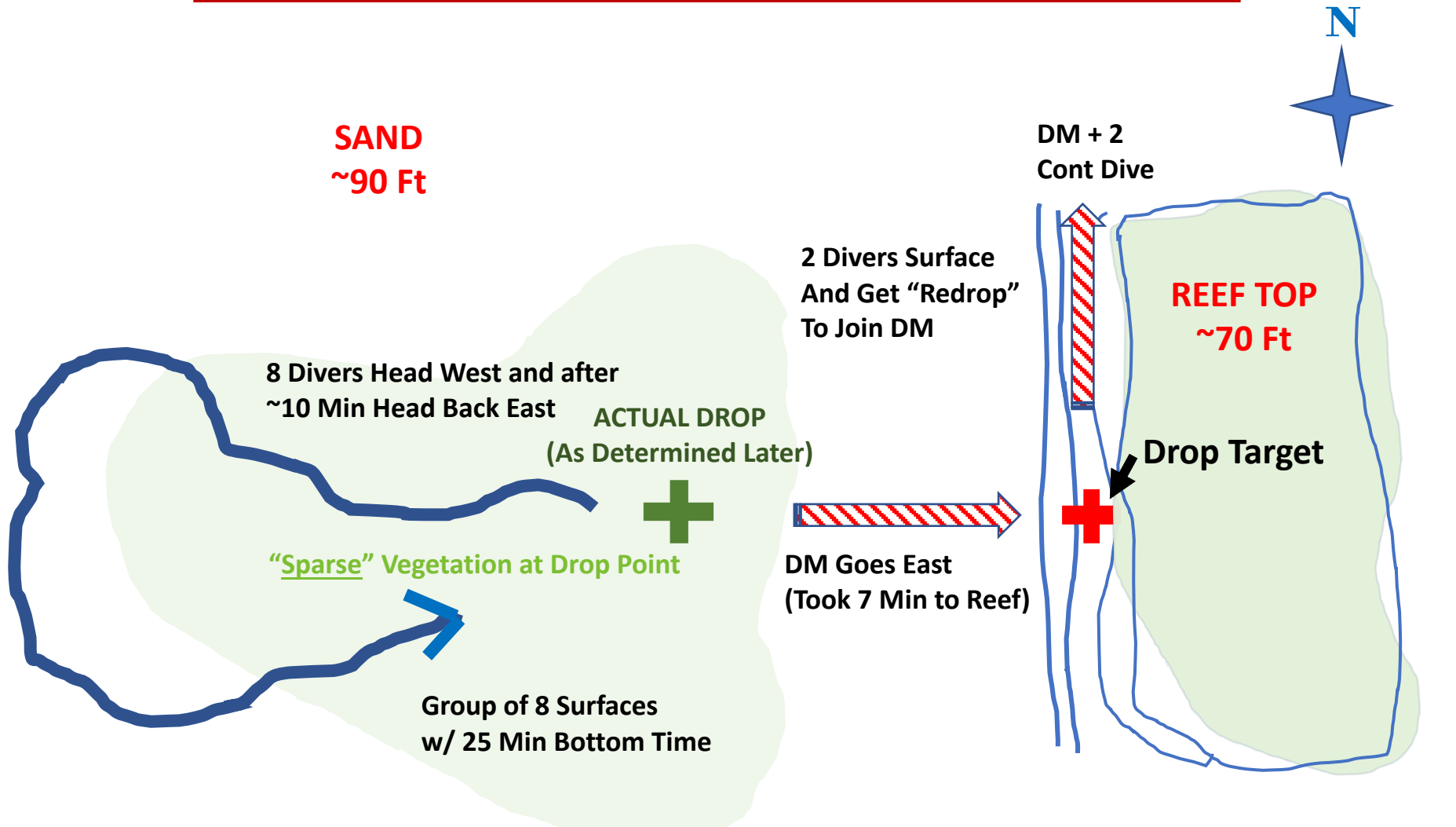


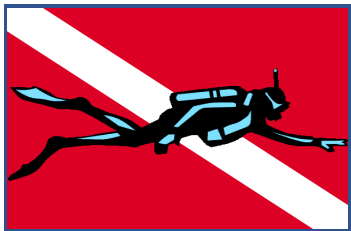
The Plan





The Execution

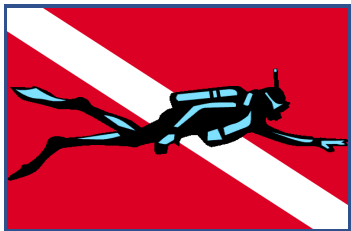




Additional Info



- During Surface Interval, Boat Captain noted that there were Three sets of Drop Coordinates for Dive Site “CAPT MIKE’S”.
- Looks like he selected the “Wrong” set of coordinates???......



Corrective Action



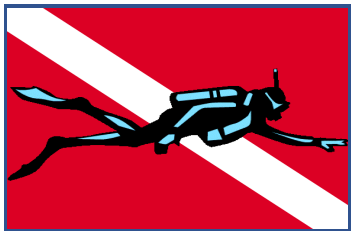
- **What Did We Do Wrong? - AND, What Should We Have Done?**

WRONG:

- **Went in WRONG Direction.**
- **Didn't Countercheck Expected Situation – ie: Depth / Terrain.**
- **Took WAY too Long to Turn Around to the East.**

SHOULD HAVE:

- **Recognized 90' depth at Drop point and headed East.**
- **Terminated dive ~3-5 min (or less) after heading East and not finding Reef.**
- **By Terminating quickly, could have had time for Re-Drop.**
