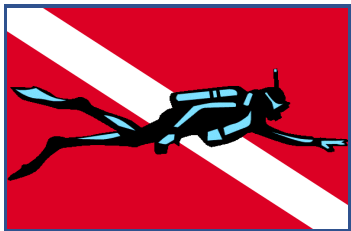

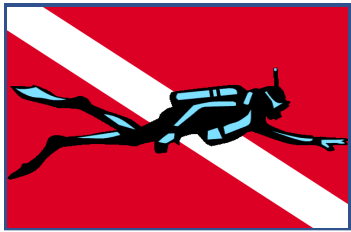

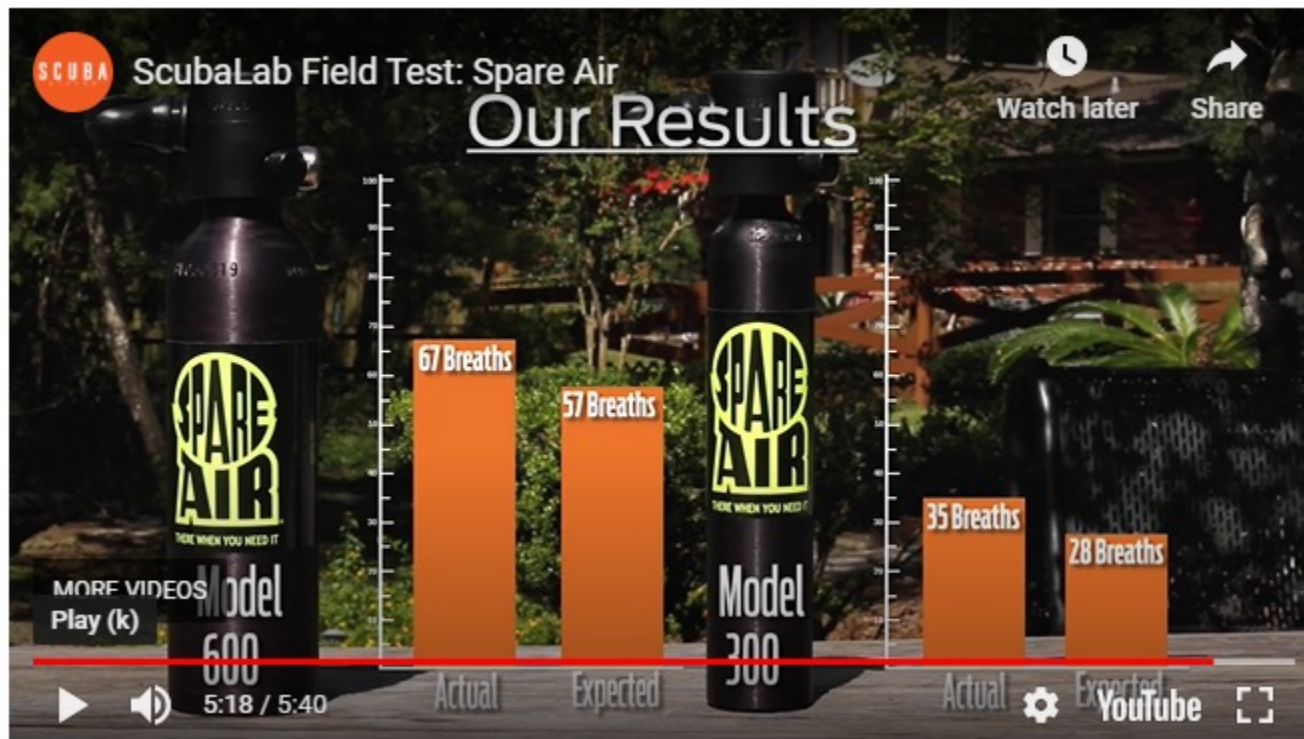
- Great Minds Think Alike:

Scubalab Field Test

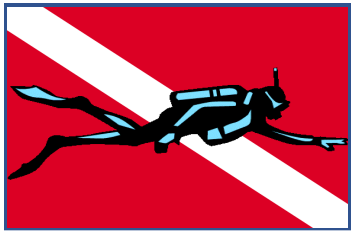


- Tested how many breaths they could get out of a SpareAir 300 and 600 at 32' compared to Surface Projections of 57 breaths and 114 breaths.

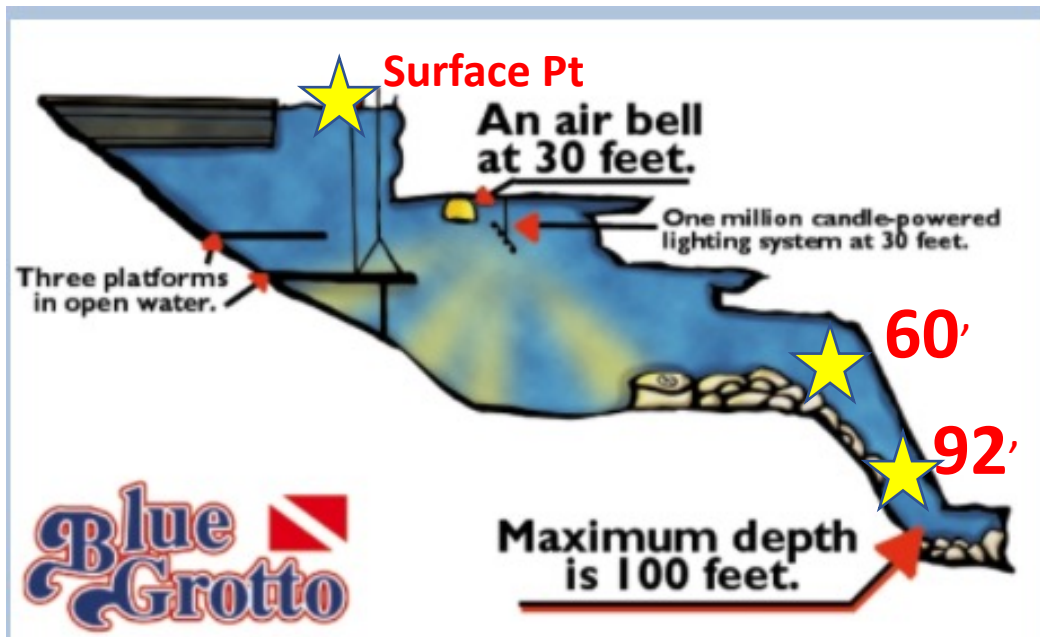
4 Min Air

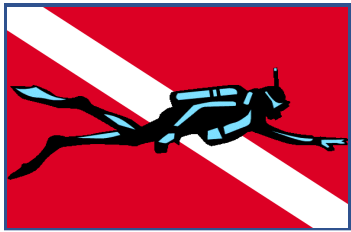


Mike and Joe Test

- Refilled and Ascended from 92' with SpareAir 300.

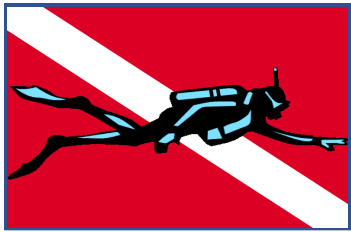

Joe/Mike Results

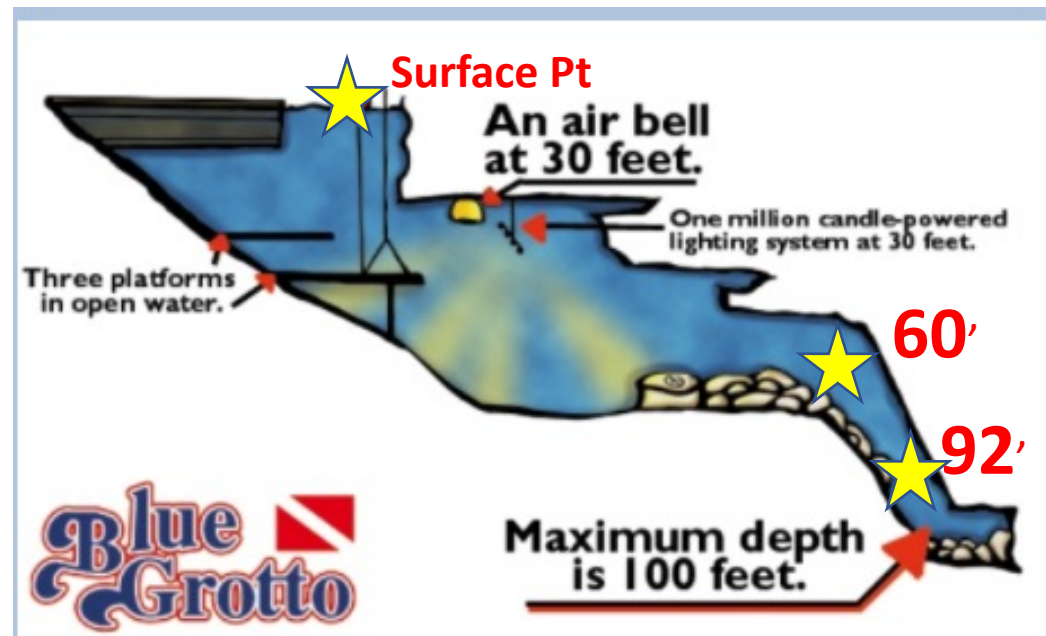


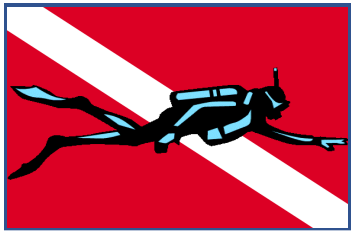
• 60 Foot Test:

- 2m 8 Sec to Surface
- .46 ft/Sec (30 ft / Min)
- 1000 lb Air Remaining
- 12 Breaths

• 92 Foot Test:

- 2 Min 55 Sec to 15'
- .52 Ft/Sec (30 Ft / Min)
- Out of Air at 15'
- 16-17 Breaths
